Prominent False Expectations

- 1) If God is good, then bad things will not happen in my life.
- 2) If I am moral (good) enough, life will be without discomfort.
- 3) If I am a "Christian," my heart is changed so I can follow my heart.
- 4) Christianity should be easy. I will automatically obey God. If not, it must be someone else's fault.
- 5) If I feel negatively, I have no control over my feelings, and it must be someone else's fault.
- 6) God's grace means he will alter truth to suit me.
- 7) Good Christians never have conflict. Conflict is bad.
- 8) Apathetic and half-hearted Christians will endure.
