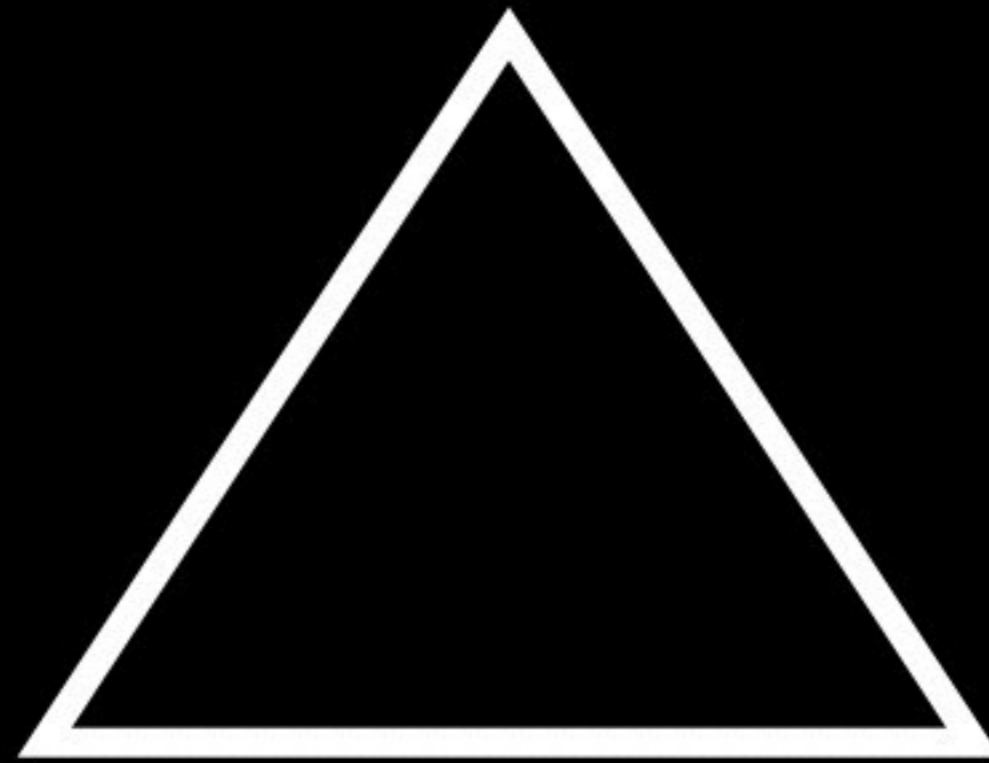

Contemplative: Dwell, Not Do (Passive)

Deliverance: Deliver, Not Do (Passive)

Reformed: Just Do It (Active)

New Covenant Sanctification:

New Identity: Child of God

New Heart: Heart of Christ

New Desires: Will of God

New Rule: The Law of Christ

New Community: Community of the
Spirit
