- 10) Recognizing we are engaged in daily spiritual warfare

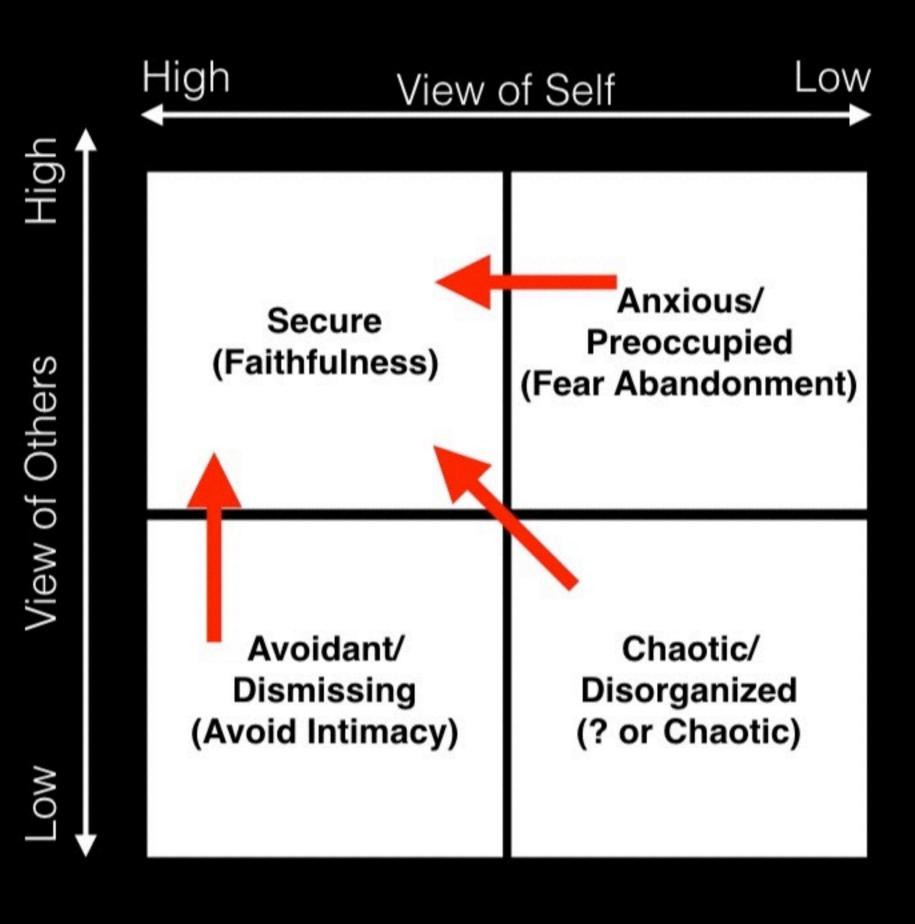
